Dr. Jason De Leon is the Professor of Anthropology at the University of Michigan and director of the Undocumented Migration Project, an ethno-archaeological and ethnographic analysis of the economics of undocumented migration in southern Arizona and northern Mexico.

Margo Cowan is the Pima County Public Defender, Sanctuary Leader, Board Member of Derechos Humanos and co-founder of the group No More Deaths, for more than 25 years Margo has been an outspoken defender of migrants and has a keen awareness and experience in border and immigration policy and law.
